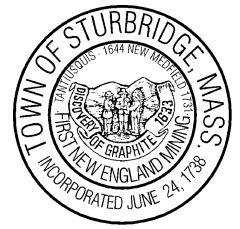

Throughout the month certified department personnel properly installed 7 child safety seats.

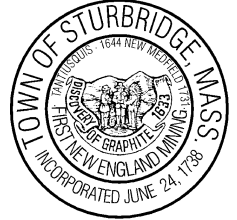
Boat Patrols were done on Cedar Lake, South Pond, Walker Pond and Long Pond throughout the month. We conducted 14 inspections.
