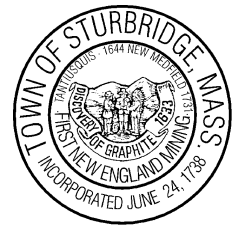

Throughout the month certified department personnel properly installed 7 child safety seats.

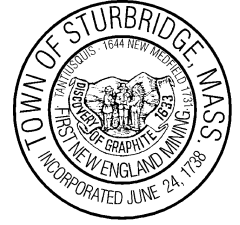
Boat Patrols were done on Big Alum, South Pond, Cedar Lake, Walker Pond and Long Pond throughout the month. We conducted 33 inspections.
