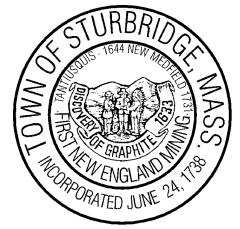

- January 27 Officer Benoit held a Driver's Education class at Tantasqua High School.

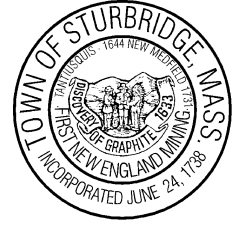
Throughout the month certified department personnel properly installed 1 child safety seats for town residents.
