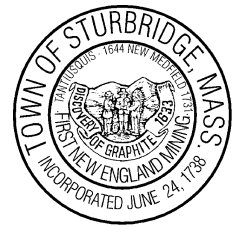

Throughout the month certified department personnel properly installed 7 child safety seats for town residents.

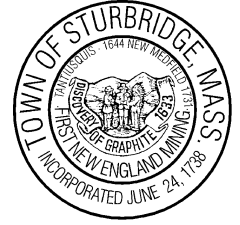
Boat Patrols were done on Big Alum, Cedar Lake, South Pond and Long Pond throughout the month. We conducted 14 inspections.
