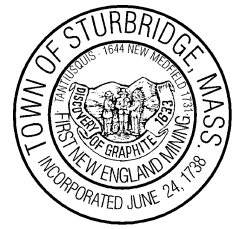

K9 Assists 4 activations in town and 4 mutual aid call.

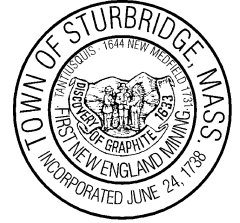
Boat Patrols were done on Big Alum, South Pond, Cedar Lake, and Long Pond throughout the month. We conducted 37 inspections.
