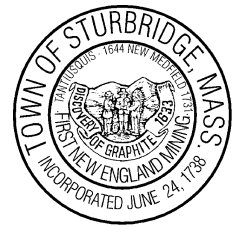

Throughout the month certified department personnel properly installed 5 child safety seats for town residents.

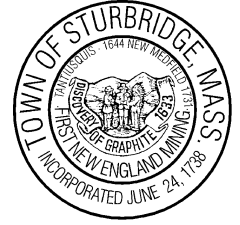
Boat Patrols were done on Cedar Lake, and Long Pond throughout the month. We conducted 9 inspections.
