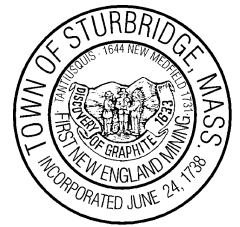

- November 24 Officer Fortier had a C.E.M.L.E.C. Swat call out to Dudley.

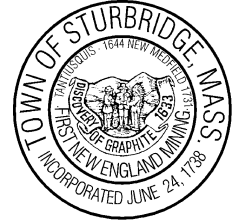
Throughout the month certified department personnel properly installed 4 child safety seats.
