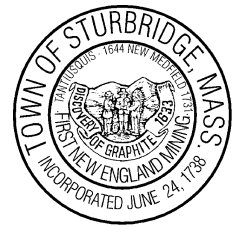

November 17            Sergeant Mercier held the S.A.L.T. meeting at the Senior Center.

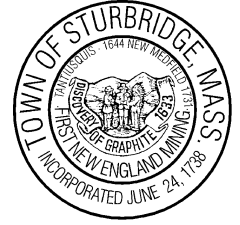
Throughout the month certified department personnel properly installed 1 child safety seat.
